The Naturist Foundation is pleased to be able to welcome visitors back to Brocken Hurst from 28th May 2021. We have had to make some changes to operate within the Government guidelines, but we are sure you will still enjoy your stay. Before booking we would like to make you aware of the following changes to the way we operate.

The swimming pool.

To prevent congestion the swimming pool has had to be roped off into lanes. There are 2 lanes that can be booked for 30 minute sessions and 2 lanes that do not require booking but are for a quick dip to cool off, one person at a time.

Showers.

We have had to keep some showers closed to maintain social distancing. A cleaning station is provided to clean the coin slots before and after use. Showers will need to be booked.

Laundry.

The laundry room is open and a cleaning station is provided to clean the coin slots and door handles on the machines before and after use. This facility must be booked.

Sauna.

The sauna is open 6pm to 8pm Tuesday and 4pm to 6pm Sunday for those who are on site at those times. It is currently maximum 2 persons per 15 minute slot, which needs to be booked. You must be socially distanced if not from the same household.

TeaPot Café and Bar.

The café is operating on a takeaway service so the hours are reduced to 10am to 4pm and the menu has been reduced. There are limited tables available in the pavilion to sit at to eat but plenty of outdoor picnic benches. The bar is operating outdoors only so is weather dependent as well as staff dependent. The bar operates on a sit-order-drink service with no takeaway service available. We aim to open it on Saturdays from 1pm to 5pm, Sundays from 12 noon to 4pm and Bank Holiday Mondays from 1pm to 5pm. Weekday opening will be dependent on weather, staff availability and number of people on site.

The café and bar take cash or card payments, but card is the preferred method.
